This page also contains information on what Cookies are examples of the Cookies used on Jamie's Italian Sites, how to manage some of these.

### **Cookies Overview**

Cookies are small text files that are stored by the browser (e.g. Internet Explorer, Chrome or Safari) on your computer or mobile. You can think of Cookies as providing a 'memory' for the website. They allow websites and apps to store things like user preferences, enabling you to navigate more efficiently between webpages, login information and generally improving your online experience.

#### Essential Cookies

These are Cookies which are required for certain features of our Sites to work.

- Cookie is stored when they select "accept cookies" — this is so the cookie consent popup does not display again.
- Cookie is stored per page view to prevent cross-site-forgery for form submissions — this is a security feature to prevent other sources from submitting POST requests to the websites.

#### Functional Cookies

Some examples of how we use these Cookies are:

- Popup dismissals (when they dismiss a popup, a cookie is set to prevent it showing again until they leave and re-enter the website);
- Location (to find nearest restaurant — cookie is stored so that we don't need to find location on every page request); and
- Language preference (to provide localisation of the content — when they select a language, a cookie is set with the language code and the content / translations are loaded using the stored language code).

### **Managing Cookies**

It is usually possible to stop your browser accepting Cookies, or to stop it accepting Cookies from a particular website. However, if you disable all Cookies we cannot tell if you are signed in and some features of our Sites may not work correctly and you may have to manually adjust some preferences every time you visit.

All modern browsers allow you to change your cookie settings. You can usually find these settings in the Options or Preferences menu of your browser. To understand these settings, the following links may be helpful, or you can use the Help option in your browser for more details.
